TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

Lancaster train station is approximately 3 miles from campus and is serviced by a regular Stagecoach bus (the X1 service) to campus (a timetable is included in your information pack). Access to the bus is at the northbound platform side of the station. Taxis are usually available from outside the station.

TRAVELLING BY ROAD

From the north or south: leave the M6 motorway at junction 33 and take the A6 north towards Lancaster and continue for 1 3/4 miles - passing through the village of Galgate. After leaving Galgate, turn right at the second set of traffic lights into the University main drive. (Do not turn right at the first set of traffic lights - signposted to Alexandra Park).

At the roundabout at the top of the drive, turn right for the Management School. The Management School is the large glass-fronted building, located just past Gillow Avenue (the third turning on the left after the roundabout). Car parking is free everywhere on campus on a Saturday.
